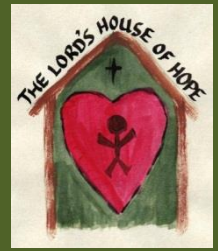

Blessings Given For the Children:

1. One child's left eye is completely blind. While Judy was there he had surgery on his right eye, it is called Cross Linking. He is seeing better with his right eye. We are so thankful for this. The Doctors at the Lion's Hospital are just amazing, with the most advance equipment!! Thanks to the child's Sponsors from the bottom of our hearts for this amazing gift that they are giving him, a chance to see!! One day after a long day at the Lion's Hospital with the child and another child, we got in the car to come back (which was over 2 hours in traffic) and not once did the children become restless. He said, "Badi please put on number 5 on the CD. - the songs starts with.....let me see YOU!!!" The child was praising and worshiping The Lord like he did not have a care in the world....it was all about HIM, his Savior!!!

Last week at the hospital the patch on child's eye was taken off and his eye was tested. He CAN SEE!! GLORY AND HONOR TO OUR SAVIOR OUR KING!!! He was able to read the first 3 lines on the eye chart.....you can imagine the joy that the room was feeling!! As everyone looked at each other with tears of joy!!

2. Cynthia is doing so well and it is only because of Our Savior!!! Judy was there a year ago and saw this child near death along with others who witnessed this. All of them have been blessed with a sign from HIM that HE will not leave HIS children!!! Thanks Be To God!!!

3. One of our children returned from going Upcountry with Malaria and Typhoid. We are overjoyed and thankful that after 3 days of shots and a week of pills that he is feeling better and back to normal.

4. Our children with HIV are doing very well. Lea Toto is the clinic that our children go to. Fridah our Social Worker used to work there and we have a strong connection with them because of Fridah. I had the opportunity to spend one morning with the Doctor and review the children's health with her and to meet the directors of the 9 different Lea Toto's. We will continue to network with them and support one another.

5. On Monday we started the tutoring process for five of our 7th and 8th graders. We are so thankful for our Educational Sponsor!! The children have had 2 sessions....Monday from 8:00 - 9:00pm and again on Wednesday. Teacher Joshua from Riverside School will also be coming on Saturday afternoons from 3:00 - 5:00. I have never ever seen children who want to study and learn like this group of children. We purchased a new table and 6 chairs for the children to study at and have placed it upstairs in the volunteer wing.

6. A couple more children have been experiencing some emotional problems from things that have happen so have been able to provide support for them at a couple different hospitals. We are pleased with the counseling and have seen change in the children. What a blessing given from above.

Blessings Given At The Orphanage:

1. We have been able to purchase the items off of our Thanksgiving Board such as beds, mattresses, bench, vacuum cleaner, dining room table and chairs, raincoats, shelves, push lawn mower, wipe off board, kitchen grater, just to name a few. What a blessing for us all. Thanks so much!!
2. We have changed the daily routine to make smoother transitions for the children which involved new shelves and a gate in the kitchen area. The staff are so excited about these changes. Following dinner the 15 younger children now have a special time for stories, finger plays, puppets, playdoh and painting. We will be supplying different items to this time thanks to many donations from all of you and also to our new Craft sponsor who joined us. The older children are in the Library doing homework during this time. We are also excited about the new bed time routine so the children will be rested and ready to go early in the morning.
3. Judy has found a plumber who we can trust.....things are improving!!
4. While the visitors were there, they had water each day....huge huge deal.....Thank you Lord!!!
5. The dogs have truly been a blessing!! One Saturday night they lost power and the generator would not work. So the guard had a lantern and the dogs, which made everyone feel more comfortable. They are friendly and have not caused any problems with any of the children or adults. They are out during the day while the children are at school and then again during the night while everyone is sleeping.
6. A projector was purchased for the children to be able to watch movies! Sunday night was the first rewards party after implementing what we would call in America "Positive Behavior Management."
